Why does this matter?

This matters because thousands of Pennsylvanians need home repairs, and **\$125 million is not nearly enough** so this year we're **going back for more!** We need **permanent and recurring funding** for years to come!



Why does this matter?

- The current funding only meets a small fraction of the state's needs.
- 64 of 67 counties in PA have applied for the current funding. This is 95% of PA's counties, covering 99% of the population.
- Whole Home Repairs creates green jobs & housing efficiency and allows for lower energy use, lower energy bills, weatherization, and helps stabilize communities, ultimately keeping us in our homes.
